## SCHOOL PROFILE

Bethel Christian Academy is a private, biblically-based, church-affiliated day school with over 300 students in grades PS - 12. Founded in 1970 as a ministry of Bethel Free Will Baptist Church, the school has more than 800 graduates. Of its graduates 90 % pursue post-secondary education: 50 % at two-year institutions and 40 % at four-year colleges or universities.

BCA is approved by the North Carolina Division of Non-Public Education and is accredited by the North Carolina Christian School Association and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools. BCA is also a member of the American Association of Christian Schools.

In pursuit of excellence in education, the mission of Bethel Christian Academy is to assist Christian parents by helping equip students to embrace biblical truth, strive for academic excellence, and model Christ-like leadership to influence their homes, churches, and communities for Christ.
