Dear Parents and Students,

We are excited to announce a special Christmas celebration taking place during the school day on **Thursday, December 18**. As part of this celebration, the entire school will come together to cheer on our **Varsity Boys Basketball Team** at their early game at **1:00 PM**. During halftime, our **High School Choir** will lead the school in a fun, interactive performance of **"The Twelve Days of Christmas."**

Each class will sing and act out their assigned day during the halftime performance. A high school choir member will work with each class, but the students will take the lead in presenting their verse.

Below is the list of grade assignments, along with **three simple dress ideas** for each day.

<b>9th Grade – 4th Day: Four Calling Birds</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear black (calling bird color)</li> <li>Wear a bird or feather accessory</li> <li>Wear a shirt with a bird image</li> </ul>	<b>4th &amp; 5th Grades – 5th Day: Five Golden Rings</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear gold jewelry or accessories</li> <li>Wear a gold headband, bow, or tie</li> <li>Wear or draw gold circles or rings</li> </ul>	<b>8th Grade – 6th Day: Six Geese a-Laying</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear white or gray</li> <li>Wear something with feathers</li> <li>Wear a goose, egg, or farm-themed image</li> </ul>
<b>7th Grade – 7th Day: Seven Swans a-Swimming</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear blue (water theme)</li> <li>Wear a swan sticker or pin</li> <li>Wear a shirt with a lake, ocean, or water scene</li> </ul>	<b>6th Grade – 8th Day: Eight Maids a-Milking</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear plaid or denim</li> <li>Wear something with a cow image</li> <li>Bring or wear a milk or farm-themed symbol</li> </ul>	<b>3rd Grade – 9th Day: Nine Ladies Dancing</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear something sparkly or sequined</li> <li>Wear bows, ribbons, or dance accessories</li> <li>Wear a shirt representing dance or music</li> </ul>
<b>2nd Grade – 10th Day: Ten Lords a-Leaping</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear royal colors (purple, gold, or red)</li> <li>Wear a crown or royal accessory</li> <li>Wear athletic clothing or sneakers (leaping theme)</li> </ul>	<b>1st Grade – 11th Day: Eleven Pipers Piping</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear something with music notes</li> <li>Wear plaid (bagpipe style)</li> <li>Wear a music-themed accessory</li> </ul>	<b>K4 &amp; K5 – 12th Day: Twelve Drummers Drumming</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Wear red or marching band colors</li> <li>Wear a drum or percussion-themed sticker</li> <li>Wear stripes or band-style accessories</li> </ul>

During the game, we will also have **school spirit competitions** and simple games. Students from all grade levels may win prizes for participation, enthusiasm, and teamwork.
