Bethel Christian Academy is a private, biblically based, church-affiliated day school with nearly 400 students in grades PS - 12. Founded in 1970 as a ministry of Bethel Free Will Baptist Church, the school has more than 950 graduates. Of its graduates, 88 % pursue postsecondary education: 61% at two-year institutions and 27% at four-year colleges or universities.

BCA is approved by the North Carolina Division of Non-Public Education and is accredited by the North Carolina Christian School Association and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools, and Cognia. BCA is also a member of the American Association of Christian Schools.

In pursuit of excellence in education, the mission of Bethel Christian Academy is to assist Christian parents by helping equip students to embrace biblical truth, strive for academic excellence, and model Christ-like leadership to influence their homes. churches. and communities for Christ.
